

Hi Everyone,

We are so very excited to be able to welcome you back soon. As we work really hard to get ready to be open for you we want to share the steps we are taking to ensure your safety and the safety of our staff.

We have come together and scrubbed all the nooks, crannies, ledges, walls, chairs, tables, doors, washrooms and closets. We have had meetings going over the new procedures and have come up with ideas to make everyone feel safe while dining with us and while working.

We will be reducing our staff size to maintain social distancing in our kitchen, it is very small and we cannot have 6 people in that small space like we used to have on busy days. We will be reducing our table service significantly to continue to give you the service you love and expect from us, to keep the social distancing well beyond the 6 feet and to support our smaller kitchen staff.

All the washrooms, doors, and counters will be regularly disinfected. After every guest we will be washing and disinfecting the tables chairs and walls then applying a sanitizer before reseating. We ask for your patience and kindness while we adapt to these increased procedures. It is going to take a lot longer to get ready for our next guest but we want to be sure we are doing it well. Again, we will only be using a few of our tables to begin with.

Our hours have changed to accommodate our smaller staff and the increased end of day clean up. We will be open Monday to Saturday 7 am to 2 pm

You can help us with this transition by considering continuing to use our take out option. We have created an online ordering system to make this easier.

If you would like to join us for in house dining, we ask that you try our reservation system or call to put your name down. We will require a name and phone number for every table in case of an outbreak so you can be contacted. We will keep this information for 30 days. Because of our reduced tables we ask that you please consider others and keep your visit time to 1.5 hours or less.

We have procedures put in place to keep minimal physical contact during your visit such as using our online menu for ordering and tap option for payment. All payments will now be done at your table to reduce the traffic near the front door. We have established “enter” only and “exit” only doors to help the traffic flow.

These times have been very challenging for everyone. We are all doing our best and look forward to serving you the best we can in these times. It will be different for sure but hopefully that family feeling you all get when visiting will still be present. We are looking forward to seeing you.
